II. MAJOR PROJECTS

<u>UF - 653 - Architecture Building Renovation & DCP Collaboratory - (Design Development)</u> <u>Cydney McGlothlin</u>

Cydney introduced herself and stated she before the committee to discuss the Architecture Building Renovation & DCP Collaboratory. David Wood, the PDC Project Manager, Chris Kuonen, and Jeffery Huber from Brooks & Scarpa, as well as Eric Kleinsteuber from KMF Architects were also on the call. Cydney said they are in the Design Development phase of the project, and this would be the last time it came to the committee. She showed the project site location and explained that they are bringing the Architecture Building up to Florida Building code standards. The DCP Collaboratory will be a new 3-story, approximately 47,000 SF building. It will house a functional creative commons space, research hub, digital modeling/fabrication space, education space, and a multipurpose hall.

The project extends north from Stadium Road to Inner Road. It also includes the Architecture Lawn with anticipated improvements to Murphree Way to the west. The project boundary does not include Gator Pond.

The new building will continue the existing curve of the Architecture building. The sidewalks will be continued. This will allow pedestrians to walk between the addition and the new building through the breezeway. There will be overhangs to increase the useable exterior space and provide shade.

Cydney displayed the renderings of the future building and the Architecture Lawn. The committee asked what the setback was from Stadium Road, and the project team responded it is 39 feet, with 30 feet being the minimum. The committee asked if there would be light sources in the walkways. The project team responded that there would be light provided.
