





Located in the Cultural Plaza East of the Harn Museum.




ASD Site Plan











- Replace the existing siding due to wood rot around the building
- Budget = \$320,000
- Tentative Construction Timeline: July September








Existing Conditions

• Wood rot in existing painted pine siding










Hawk's Nest

- Identified Red-Shouldered Hawk Nest
 - Protected in North America under the Migratory Bird Act
 - Upon discovery, construction rescheduled to mid July in order to not disrupt nesting season
